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GET A NEW BAG!

As you update your look from summer's satchels to fall's large totes, why not find a new makeup bag for all your beauty favorites?

WHAT TO TOSS

BRONZE-GODDESS MAKEUP Even well-applied bronzer looks wrong in the fall. Instead, Gina Brooke of Shu Uemura recommends a light-reflecting highlighter on your eyelids or high on the cheekbones.

DARK FOUNDATIONS "Ditch summer's darker foundations and concealers," says Alexis Comforti, makeup artist for Laura Mercier. A shade or two lighter, with the same undertones, is better in autumn.

BEACHY BRIGHTS Leave coral lipsticks in the beach tote—invest in a classic red or crimson-tinted gloss for a subtler look, suggests Lee Graff.

PASTEL SHADES Replace pink-colored shadows with warmer tones. "Plums and aubergines are in this season," says Brooke.

WHEN TO TOSS IT

MASCARA Replace every two to three months or if it gets dry. Darac's tip: Don't pump mascara. That forces air in, drying it out faster.

LIP COLOR Lip products in a tube "last up to a year because they're not exposed to the germs on our hands," says NYC dermatologist David Colbert. Potted gloss will last as long as nine months.

LIQUID MAKEUP Eye primers, liquid foundations and glosses are good for six to nine months.

DRY MAKEUP Throw away eye shadows, pressed powders, blush and pencils after a year. ■
