2 CHEEK BOOSTER

4 These two at-home gadgets are worthy of your investment. The JeNu wand (right) uses ultrasound to push antiaging ingredients "through the skin's otherwise very effective barrier," says dermatologist Sonia Batra, allowing the anti-agers to work faster and more efficiently. And StriVectinLabs' electrotherapy toner (left) is like a workout for your face muscles. The headphone-like device is placed on your cheekbones so microcurrents can stimulate and firm underlying tissues.
