The loose crop

"A loosely cropped haircut, which also has some texture and length on the side and back, is perfect for the new season," says Carmelo Guastella, men's grooming director at Gielly Green, "Ask for the hair on top to be cut to around 2-3cm. The sides should be a touch shorter, while the hairline around the ears and neck should be finished imperfectly. Oh, and ask for the fringe to be irregular and choppy. Noninvasive skin tightening and cosmetic dermatology are combined to redefine the jawline and reduce the appearance of loose skin beneath the chin. The two-hour treatment (currently available at Harrods' Wellness Clinic) includes - among other things - an ultrasound treatment, which lifts, tones and tightens loose skin, and hyaluronic gel structuring, which adds volume and definition.
